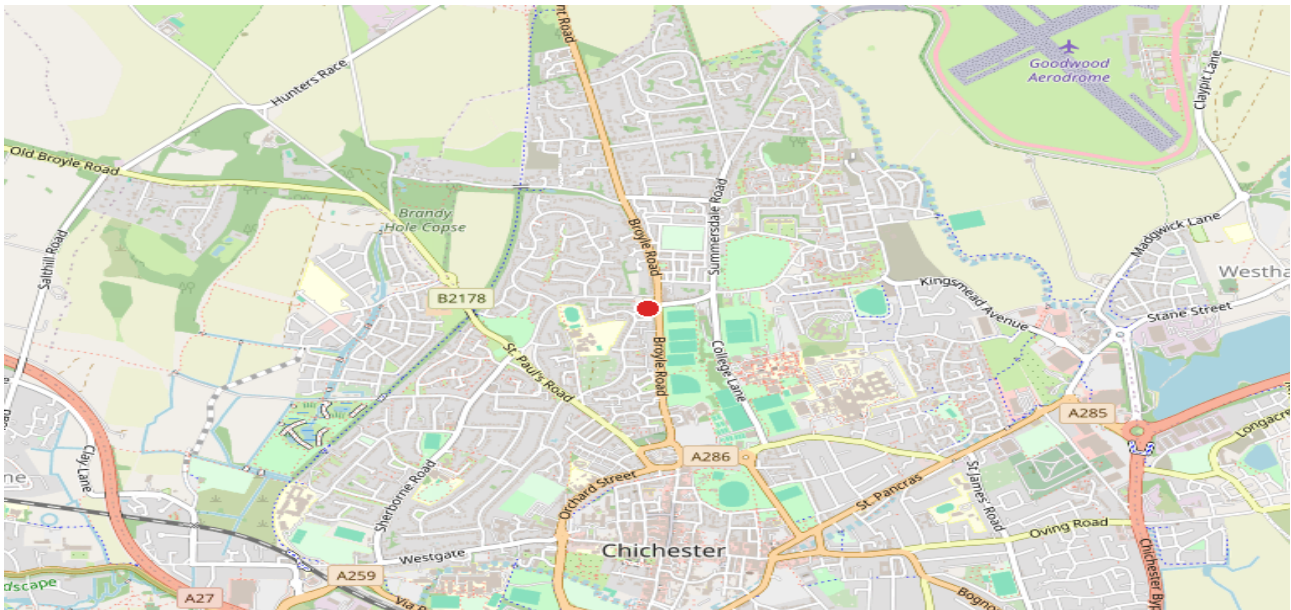

- **Care** — 62.5/100 (good)

Good healthcare access with 4 GP surgeries and 6 pharmacies nearby.

- **Active** — 55.8/100 (average)

Strong fitness infrastructure with 3 leisure centres and 5 gyms available locally.

Areas to Investigate

Methodology

Score Calculation

AgeWell Finder scores towns across five pillars: Care (healthcare access), Green (parks and nature), Active (fitness and leisure facilities), Community (social infrastructure), and Transport (public transit). Each pillar is calculated as a per-capita normalised metric, comparing amenity density across all towns in the database. Scores range from 0–100, where 100 represents the best performance in that category.

Data Sources

Amenity locations and details are sourced from OpenStreetMap (OSM), a community-maintained geographic database. Population and house price data come from the UK Office for National Statistics (ONS) and comparable national statistical agencies.

Search Radius

Amenities are counted within a 2 km radius of each town centre. For smaller towns or rural areas, the search radius may be extended to 5 km to ensure adequate data coverage.

Per-Capita Normalisation

Raw amenity counts are normalised per 10,000 residents to ensure fair comparison between large cities and small towns. A town with 5 gyms and 100,000 residents scores the same as a town with 1 gym and 20,000 residents in the Active category.

Score Interpretation

Scores are relative rankings within the AgeWell Finder database. A score of 80 means this town performs in the top 20% for that pillar. The overall score is the equal-weighted average of all five pillars.

Limitations

This report is a point-in-time snapshot. Amenity availability changes frequently. Some areas may be underrepresented in OSM due to crowdsourced data collection patterns. House prices are medians and may not reflect current market rates. For detailed property searches, consult estate agents and property websites.
